SD-SEED has conducted program on 'Mind Concentration' for the students of Std 8, 9 & 10. The Trainer explained and demonstrated the importance of concentration, steps to increase concentration and methods to maintain concentration, etc.

**Objective:** Mind Concentration is necessary for effective studies. Students should develop a sense of determination towards hard work and study regularly in order to succeed academically, which will support them in reaching the pinnacle of success.

**The guide gave following demonstrations for development of concentration:**

1. **Peace of Mind:** Every day we all face tension and stressful situations. When this stress increases, it affects our health and work. The Trainer demonstrated on how to reduce this stress. The students were made to sit a little apart, close their eyes, concentrate on their breathing and were explained on how to concentrate using the picture that comes before their eyes.



2. **Number Counting:** Students had to say even numbers in reverse order that is from 100 to 1. When we have to say number in regular order we say it properly, but when we have to say it in reverse order we falter. This requires us to concentrate and focus on the numbers.



3. The students were given names of 15 objects from their daily life, including eatables, educational material, fruits, flowers, etc. The students were asked to memorize them and say the names of as many objects as they could. Those students who listened with concentration could remember most numbers of objects.



**The Trainer gave the students the following tips to help them concentrate on their studies:**

- \* Time management and strictly following the same while studying
- \* Study one subject at time and concentrate fully on that subject
- \* The place and posture of sitting to study should be proper
- \* Maintain a stable posture while studying
- \* Include some exercise and yoga in your schedule

# UPSC or MPSC?



Many students are confronted with the question whether to attempt UPSC or MPSC, but there is no need to be confused. Today both these exams are parallel to each other. You can attempt them simultaneously attempted and also be successful in both the exams. Looking at this year's results, you can even be successful in the very first attempt. This year, one candidate has successfully cleared MPSC in the first attempt and is now Dy. Collector. Further this candidate cleared the UPSC exam with a rank. It has been observed that those candidates, who seriously attempt competitive exams successfully, clear the same and get a good posting. Secondly, securing a key designation or posting does not guarantee your further success. You should also attempt lesser important or lower grade exams, like Mantralaya, Assistant, Sales Tax Inspector. You should not underestimate any designation or post or exam. After successfully get your first posting, your confidence will increase and this will give you the motivation to be successful in other exams. It is said, there is no success like being successful.

### ★ Do not be complacent

Once you are successful in securing a posting, your determination of achieving your next goal should not reduce. You tend to get carried away by all the felicitation and compliments you receive on your achievement and may lose sight of your next goal. However, if you review this year's results you would see that the candidates have overcome difficulties and are successful. In short, it is not easy to again start studying for the exams, but some students have done this and shown that they can better their rank. If you have strong willpower then you can overcome all your problems.

### ★ Efforts to secure the highest rank

Some students put in 100% diligent efforts and secure the highest rank. In this year's list, there is a candidate who attempted the exam in 2009, but he was not successful even though he reached the interview level. Thereafter in 2010, he tried again and secured the 228th rank, in 2011 he got 410th rank, in 2013 he stood 215th and finally in 2015 he secured the 164th rank. He used Indian Revenue Service (IRS), Indian Police Service (IPS) as stepping stones and finally got a posting in Indian Administrative Service (IAS). This determination is commendable. There are such gritty candidates who are not satisfied with little success, but have committedly tried again and again. 'Fight unto Death' should be our motto. 'Dreams are not those we see while sleeping, but those we see while we are awake', these are the words of Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam. Those who dream while they are awake and work with determination to make them a reality are the people who are successful.

### ★ New criteria of success

Many have attempted the exams while working and secured a good posting. This proves that constant studying does not guarantee a good posting. It is irrelevant whether a student studies or works while attempting such competitive exams. The decisive and crucial points are the focus of the student, his continuity and his preparation with determined efforts. It is a fact that all successful students do not have book knowledge, some of them are talented, but to achieve a goal we need to keep our hobbies aside briefly.

## How to manage time?

In today's fast paced life, it is crucial to have proper time management, which will help in prioritizing and completing your work. When you try to complete work in haste, it leads to slippage of important and even planned tasks. If we plan taking into consideration various adverse scenarios, we can remain in control of the situation.



### 1. Planning and scheduling

If you devote some time to think on the tasks you need to complete, you will complete them in a planned manner and manage your time properly. Plans made without thinking have greater chances of failure. When you are planning anything you should keep various possibilities in mind, which will avoid chaos and confusion.

### 2. The importance of an Aim or Goal

You should always have an aim or goal, which will help you to achieve your goal within the time you have allocated and in the right direction. Define the objective from the beginning and also plan the method, time frame and means of achieving this objective. The objective should primarily be a target you can achieve.

### 3. Prioritizing

When you are aiming to achieve your goal, you should use Italian Economist Pareto's, 80-20 rule. He has said that to achieve 80% of your objective, you need to put in 20% effort. It is also necessary to identify and understand which are the 20% important efforts, which you can then prioritize. Thus, you will give priority to activities which are beneficial or fruitful.

### 4. Flexibility

There are chances that something may go wrong, you may be distracted, or hurdles will come in your way, etc. We should prioritize work, keeping all these points in mind and plan accordingly. Time management experts suggest that we should plan for 50% of our time and accordingly prioritize our work. By making time table for half of the time and the remaining time can be devoted for any hurdles or problems that may come up.

### 5. Remember Most productive times

It is best to complete your work during the time when you are most alert active physically and mentally. Mostly, you are likely to be fresh and alert in the morning hours. Some of you like to work in night, or prefer working in the afternoon, you can carry out your important work at that time and it would yield faster and qualitative results. The most effective way of time management is to allocate proper time for completing important and key issues.

### 6. Doing essential work properly

Internationally renowned Management Guru, Peter Drucker says, doing the right thing is more important than doing it in the right way. When you do the right things you get the expected results. You should focus and concentrate on doing the right things in the right way based on your capability.

### 7. Avoid doing things hastily and in urgency

The result of activities done in a hurried manner is short lived, whereas result of important activities is long lived and these important activities are interrelated to your objective. Hence you should try to have lesser number of urgent activities, which will give you sufficient time to complete your important and priority work.
