**CHALLENGES TO SD-SEED**

Considering the dropout rate of students, the Governing Body Members, Taluka Coordinators and Associates of SD-SEED were approached by students and their parents to know the reasons for dropout. SD-SEED studied this issue, found that there are many reasons and accordingly measures were planned reason-wise. However, the two most important reasons are lack of educational awareness among parents to complete their children's education and lack of interaction between Parents-Teacher-Student. It was unanimously decided to primarily focus on these reasons. As a first step, to create educational awareness among the parents and students, counseling sessions and workshops were organized at Taluka level. In addition to this, training programs were organized for the teachers on how they can increase their interaction with parents and students. Currently, parent counseling programs are receiving a modest response, but we see tremendous positivity among those who participating to overcome these issues. We are constantly organizing such workshops and hope it will definitely create educational awareness among parents and reduce the number of drop-outs. In the last month we conducted one program each on Parent Counseling and Teacher Training and the synopsis is given below:
