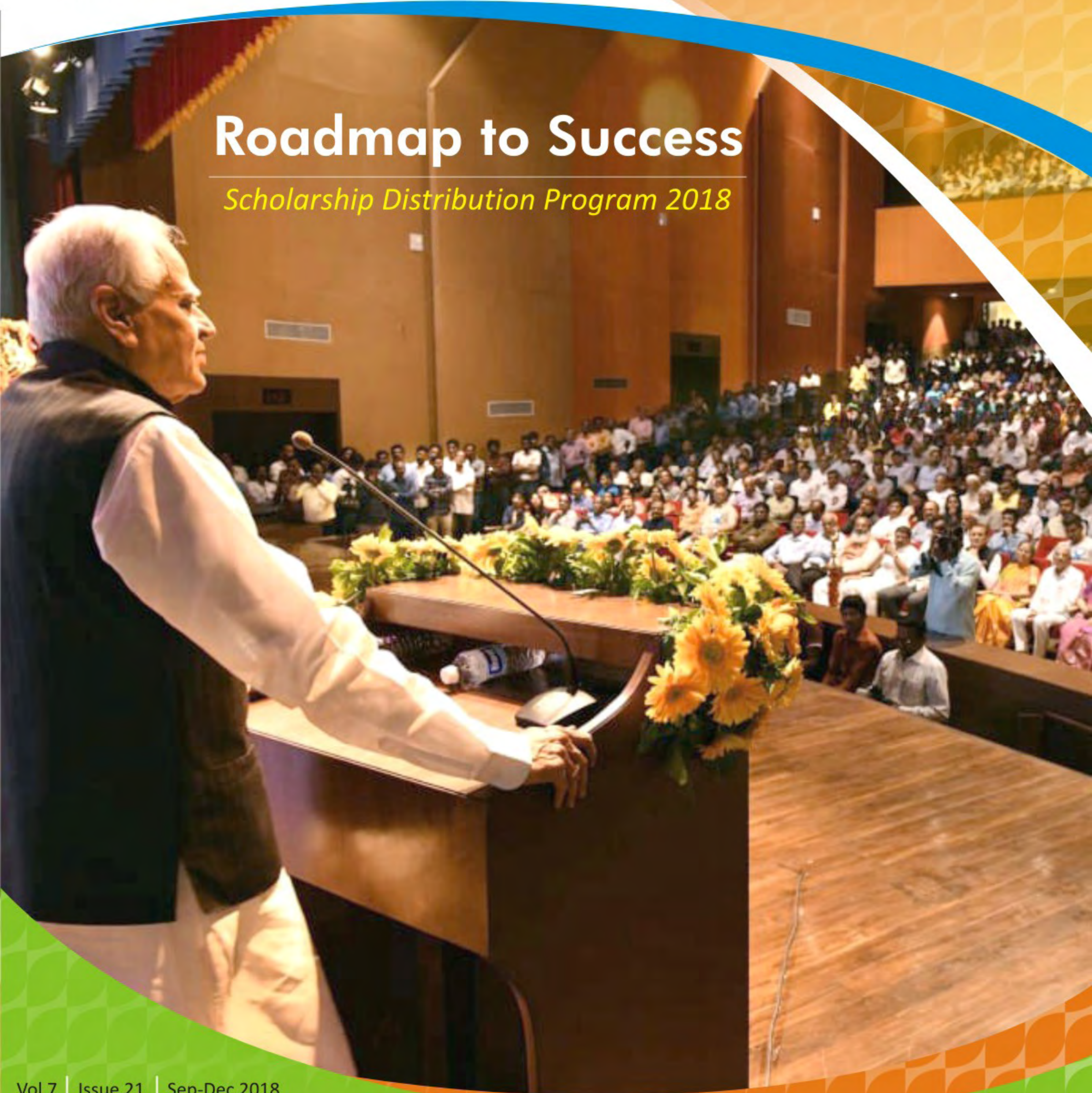

## 'Preparing for 'NEET' Exam'



The National Eligibility cum Entrance Test or NEET is an entrance examination in India, required for admission to medical courses. It has been found that very few students are aware of this exam. This article highlights the syllabus and structure of the exam and techniques to be used while preparing for the exam.

### NEET is easy

The marks scored in Class 10 are useful only to secure admission in a good college. The syllabus is very limited and if the student learns it by heart, he/she can easily score 95%. Hence, these marks cannot be used to gauge the students' intelligence. There is a difference in understanding a topic and learning it by heart. In the CET exam it is possible to learn by heart and answer the exam, but for NEET exam students should essentially understand the concepts, which will help them in answering effortlessly.

### Eligibility

- Student should be an Indian citizen.
- In Class 12, student should pass Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Biotechnology and English.
- **Students should score the following minimum:**
  - Open Category: 50%
  - SC/ST and OBC Category: 40%
  - Physically Challenged Students: 45%

### Admission process

Based on the results of this exam, students can secure admission in various medical related courses such as, MBBS, BDS, Ayurveda, Homeopathy, Paramedical, Nursing, etc. If in a College 85% students are from the State, then the balance 15% is allotted for students from other States.

### How to study?

NEET is a very important competitive exam for medical students. It is important for them to study in an in-depth and well-planned manner, as the syllabus is extensive. The questions asked for this exam are based on knowledge, application, skill and understanding and very few math related questions are asked. Primarily students should thoroughly study Class 11 & 12 NCERT syllabus and understand the concepts. They should aim to score high marks in Class 12, as very often many students achieve high scores in CET/NEET, but they are not able to score

even 50% in Physics, Chemistry & Biology (PCB), which might result in the student losing a year in his education. Hence it is important for students to achieve a minimum of 50% in PCB.

### Paper pattern

PCB is important for NEET. The question paper comprises of 180 Multiple Choice questions of 4 marks each totaling to 720 marks. These are divided into 45 questions each for Physics & Chemistry respectively and the balance 90 questions are related to Biology. These questions are divided on three levels of difficulty, i.e. L1 (60 easy questions), L2 (60 medium difficulty questions) and L3 (60 difficult questions). Hence all questions of NEET are not difficult. Choose the right option while answering the paper, because of negative marking students may lose marks. The duration of the exam is three hours and students should keep an eye on the watch while answering the questions. The question paper is prepared for common students and hence no one should get scared.

### Reference books

The syllabus of the exam is based on Class 11 and 12 books. Students should read and attempt to answer questions based on the Synopsis in NCERT Fingertips. Do not be under the false notion that by going for a Class, you will know everything. Self-study is important. Get acquainted with the questions, since you need to answer one question per minute. Give equal importance to self-study and practice tests. Students concentrate on the Class 12 exams in December.

3. CBSE Paper Solutions
